The Bush Fire Advisory Committee is to represent Volunteer Bush Fire Brigades within the Municipality and to make recommendations to Council on the following:

- 1. Annual bushfire budget and relevant financial matters.
- 2. General management and communication within the Bushfire organisation.
- 3. Planning, setting standards and works program for fire prevention within the Shire.
- 4. Formation, rationalisation or winding up of any Bush Fire Brigades within the Shire.
- 5. Standards of equipment that should be provided and maintained under Brigade control.
- 6. Distribution of firefighting equipment and funding between Brigades.
- 7. Coordination of training to ensure Brigades can work together efficiently.
- 8. Review of Council's Fire Protection Strategy.
- 9. Any other matter relating to bushfire control.
- 10. The committee will establish working groups as necessary.
