#### Community Survey

The 2021 Community Survey is out now. You are very strongly encouraged to take the time to complete the survey. Rather than go to social media to make your comments, make them on the community survey, this is your chance to shape the future of your region. Results from the community survey are used to form the basis of the Shire's strategic plan for the next 10 years.

In a very real sense the plan empowers the community and enables the Shire's decisions and actions to work directly towards the achievement of community identified goals and priorities. The Plan is a document owned by the community. The outcomes and strategies all stem from input gained from the community through community engagement.

The 2016 census data has the Shire's population at 9250, with 1733 of those being aged 0-14, that leaves 7517 residents that could supposedly complete the survey, in the previous survey we received about 600(6.5%) responses, lets beat that. Give us the real picture so that we can implement the real hopes and visions of the community.

#### Climate Change Response Community Consultation

As part of the review of the Strategic Community Plan, the Shire is undertaking community consultation on climate change response. Community workshops will assist in identifying and collating community feedback to inform the Shire's climate change adaptation, mitigation and advocacy actions.

Interested persons are encouraged to attend one of the workshops if possible. Reference documents for the workshop are available on the Shire's website and include an extract from the Shire's current Corporate Business Plan, detailing the environmental activities your Council has identified as being of importance to the community and a copy of the workshop presentation.

#### Pemberton Trails Master Plan

A Trails Master Plan has been developed for Pemberton by consultants Common Ground Trails. The project is a collaboration between the Shire of Manjimup, Department of Biodiversity, Conservation and Attractions, Department of Local Government, Sport and Cultural Industries, Pemberton Visitor Centre and Pemberton Cycling Association. The Master Plan covers non-motorised trails in the Pemberton region including walking, running, mountain biking, cycling, horse riding and canoeing/kayaking. The Draft outlines a vision for Pemberton to be recognised as a premier destination for enjoying the outdoors, with trails as the focus providing captivating experiences and connections. The Draft Master Plan is now available for community comment and can be downloaded on the Shire's website.
