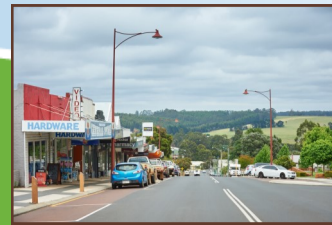

Rea Park and Collier Street Precinct Redevelopment

A major redevelopment of the Rea Park and Collier Street recreational grounds is in the early planning stages. The vision for the precinct is to transform the existing multi-use reserve into a premier level facility catering for high level sporting events, in addition to regular club usage and non-sporting events such as the annual Warren District Agricultural Show. The redeveloped precinct is to accommodate regional sporting carnivals and competitions that require multiple sporting fields and draw large crowds. The MRCR project consists of a large number of project components, including a new pavilion, upgraded sporting fields, new flood lighting, car parking, landscaping, power upgrade, etc.

The project, to be undertaken in four stages, is expected to span up to five years, with the planning and design stage aiming to make the project "shovel ready".

Workshops have been held with current stakeholders and a community consultation forum will be held on 17 May 2021 with a community survey to follow.

Annual Hard Waste Collection

The annual hard waste collection is taking place this month. This annual service is provided by the Shire for landowners who receive a regular weekly kerbside collection service.

Hard waste is defined as furniture and other household goods. In the interest of safety we ask that you only place your items on the kerb the week before your collection date.

New Aged Care Facility for Manjimup

Manjimup is set for a new aged care facility following the signing of a 42 year lease agreement between the Shire of Manjimup and Baptistcare. Part of the former Warren District Hospital site, the vacant land is 20,147m² and will serve as a brand new modern aged care facility replacing "Moonya Residential Care" which Baptistcare have operated since 2001.

The provision of a modern aged care facility so close to the Manjimup Hospital will better serve the needs of the community. Relocation of the facility to adjoin the Warren Health Service may open up service sharing opportunities whilst also reducing the need to call on the local volunteer ambulance service to undertake patient transfers between the hospital and the facility.

The new high aged care facility will now enter the planning phase and is hoped to be completed by 2024.

Waste Management

Annual Vergeside Hard Waste Collection May 2021

The Shire of Manjimup provides a free annual hard waste collection service.

♦ This service is only available to domestic properties which have an existing regular kerbside rubbish bin collection service.

♦ The service will collect:

- Old furniture, televisions, stereos, mattresses, carpet, lino and other household hard waste, air-conditioners and other whitegoods.

♦ Refrigerators and freezers **MUST** have doors completely removed before being placed on the verge.

♦ The service will **NOT** collect:

- general domestic waste (food scraps etc)
- asbestos
- gas cylinders, other hazardous materials
- green waste (lawn clippings or tree limbs)
- liquid waste (oils, paints, chemicals etc)
- building materials (cement, bricks, rubble, renovation discards, fluoro light tubes)
- crates, pallets, shopping trolleys
- vehicle tyres or batteries

Hard waste collections start:

Manjimup, Deanmill, Jardee & Palgarup	from Monday 10/05/21
Northcliffe, Windy Harbour, Pemberton, Browns Road, Quininnup & Walpole	from Monday 17/05/21

- ♦ Please put your items out on your verge **not more than one week** before your town's collection start date.
- ♦ Please do not put items out after the Monday start date for collection in your town as it may not be collected, possibly resulting in a litter infringement and fine.
- ♦ Please ensure your hard waste does not obstruct the footpath for pedestrians or lines of sight for drivers.
- ♦ Each household's waste items must be placed only on their own section of verge; households shall not add their waste to another property's verge area.
- ♦ A maximum of 3 cubic metres (1m x 1m x 3m) may be collected per property. Properties with more than 3 cubic metres will have to make private arrangements to have their waste removed. Items longer than 2m will not be collected.
- ♦ Browsing hard waste on the verge is not essential and therefore is contrary to Western Australia's COVID-19 Public Health Emergency Declaration.
- ♦ Because of the risk of spreading the COVID-19 virus, the removal of any item from vergeside hard waste by a third party is strictly prohibited.
