New Aged Care Facility for Manjimup

Manjimup is set for a new aged care facility following the signing of a 42 year lease agreement between the Shire of

Manjimup and Baptistcare. Part of the former Warren District Hospital site, the vacant land is 20,147m² and will serve as a brand new modern aged care facility replacing "Moonya Residential Care" which Baptistcare have operated since 2001.

The new high aged care facility will now enter the planning phase and is hoped to be completed by 2024.
