CONSERVATION OF FUNCTIONAL OBJECTS

with David Hallam from R.M.Tait & Associates

This workshop will see participants working together with David to discuss, assess and treat selected items from the former World of Energy collection.

Objects works through mechanical, electrical, hydraulic, or pneumatic means, but in each case their function is an integral part of the object, and a significant part of the information it provides. Participants will also learn about the decision making process for treating and preserving functional objects, and how to maintain functional objects on display and in storage.
